



Call for nomination of members to serve in the Limpopo Heritage Resources Authority (LIHRA) Council.

The Limpopo Member of the Executive Council (MEC) for Department of Sport Arts and Culture invites members of the public to nominate persons for consideration in the appointment of Limpopo Heritage Resource Council. This invitation is served in terms of section 23 of National Heritage Resources Act, 25 of 1999 and Limpopo Heritage Regulations, 103 of 2003.

Minimum Requirements: Nominees should be South African Citizens, be permanent residence of Limpopo Province, possess a broad range of experience and skills in archaeology, history, palaeontology, anthropology, law, social history, Indigenous Knowledge Systems, financial management, law, urban planning.

Functions of LIHRA Council: To provide oversight in the performance of LIHRA, to give strategic direction to LIHRA, to advise Member of Executive Council on the implementation of heritage management legal framework, to establish LIHRA to fulfil its legal obligations, to develop policies that will enable LIHRA to perform its duties, and to develop durable Limpopo Heritage Management Systems attractive to investment.

Duration of the council: The council is appointed for a period of three years. Nominees are not allowed to serve in more than two terms. New nomination should be served per call even for former council members legible to serve for second time. All rights to appoint the LIHRA Council are reserved.

Nomination procedure: Respondents are expected to submit nomination letter, acceptance letter of the nominee, and abridged curriculum vitae accompanied by certified qualification certificates of the nominees.
