LIMPOPO PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT TO COMMEMORATE THE ANNUAL HERITAGE DAY 2023 IN ZWIGODINI VILLAGE, MUSINA MUNICIAPLITY

The Limpopo Provincial Government will commemorate the Heritage Day 2023 under the theme, "**Celebrating our cultural diversity in a democratic South Africa.**" This year's theme puts a spotlight on the country's rich, unique, and diverse cultural heritage, which incorporates African, Asian, and European cultures and traditions.

In Limpopo, Heritage Day will be utilised as a vehicle to remember and recognise cultural heritage of the diverse cultures of Tsonga, Venda, Pedi, Afrikaans, English, Ndebele, Swati, Indian, Coloured and Tswana that make up the population of the province.
