## THE DEPARTMENT OF SPORT, ARTS AND CULTURE TO HOST I CHOOSE 2 B ACTIVE BOOTCAMP COMMUNITY OUTREACH EXERCISE ACTIVATION

**Saturday, 11 June 2022** will see the National Department of Sport, Arts and Culture host the I Choose 2 B Active Bootcamp in collaboration with Limpopo's Provincial Department of Sport, Arts Culture as well as the Thulamela Local Municipality in the Vhembe District of Thohoyandou.

This community outreach activation, which will take place at the Thohoyandou National Botanical Garden is intended to mobilise citizens from communities in Limpopo to be empowered with how to skills which they can use daily to embrace positive and physically active lifestyle habits.

Launched in 2015 by the Department of Sport, Arts and Culture, the I Choose 2 B Active campaign is a 365day call to action campaign intended to encourage all South Africans to pursue, commit to life-long habits of being physically active regularly and in turn encourage others to follow suit in embracing these positive healthy living habits.

The activation will feature Certified instructors engaging a community of healthy-inspired participants working out with instructors in the Thohoyandou National Botanical Garden to challenge head-on the norm of sedentary lifestyles, hence the apt reference to this bootcamp being known as Ayihlome Ihlasele Bootcamp.
